COVID-19 GUIDANCE

- **Households:** On the day of your arrival you will be designated a Household (**Yellow** or **Blue**). Residents will not be able to mix within households. You should only use your designated household kitchen and TV room.
- **Face Coverings:** Face coverings must be worn in all areas of the hall when you are outside of your bedroom. You will be expected to wear them when preparing food in the kitchen, but you may remove them whilst you are eating.
- **Maximum room capacities:** Each room has a safe maximum number of people at any one time. Signs on the door indicate the room limits.
- **2m distance:** You are always expected to remain 2m apart where possible.
- **Regular handwashing:** You should continue to practice excellent personal hygiene. Wash your hands regularly for 20 seconds or more and avoid touching your face.
- **Sanitising stations:** There will be sanitising stations at the entrance to every hall, please make good use of them.
- **Guests:** Currently, it is not possible to allow any guests within halls. This includes Imperial students living in other College residences. This rule will be revised.

Do you need to self-isolate?

Please let the Hall Supervisor know that you will be self-isolating. Once you arrive to halls you will remain in bedroom except when using kitchen, shared bathroom or collecting deliveries (during which face coverings must be worn).
